

FAQs graduation ceremony 2021-22

General inquiries

1. Where will the graduation ceremonies for the 2021-22 academic year be held?

All events will be held at the [La Salle Bonanova Theatre](#). Access is via [C/de la Ribagorça](#), a narrow street located heading down from the main entrance of La Salle Campus Barcelona towards Plaza de la Bonanova, on the right hand side.

2. How long will the acts last?

The acts will last, more or less, one hour and a half.

3. What happens if I cannot attend the graduation ceremony?

If you haven't registered, nothing happens.

If you are registered, it is important that you give this information to the email graduacio@salle.url.edu so that we can cancel your tickets and you don't be mentioned during the event.

4. How do I know which ceremony I have to go to?

On the website you will find information on the day and time of your graduation ceremony.

5. In what language will the graduation ceremonies be held?

In the three official languages of the Campus: Catalan, Spanish and English.

6. If I have not presented my TFG or TFM, can I attend the event?

Yes, because during the act no diploma will be delivered, the only requirement is to be enrolled in the TFG or TGM for the first time in the academic year 2021-2022.

Tickets and access

7. How many people can I invite to my graduation ceremony?

Due to capacity limitations, the number of companions varies depending of the event:

· If you are student of Architecture (Degrees and Master's degrees), Engineering (Degrees and Master's degrees), Animation & VFX and Digital Arts or Business & Management (Degrees) you can invite up to three companions.

· If you are a student of Business & Management (Master's Degrees) you can invite up to two companions.

As of June 5, when registration closes, we will inform you of the possibility of getting additional tickets.

8. Do children count when inviting attendees? And the babies?

If the child occupies a seat, he does count as a guest, but if he/she does not occupy a seat and seats with a family member, you do not have to get a ticket for them.

9. Where can I get the tickets for my event?

On the website you will find the button with the link to the virtual store.

10. Do I have to bring printed tickets? Or is QR enough?

Both options are valid.

11. If I want to watch it streaming, where can I get the link from? Can more than one user watch the stream with the same link?

You can connect through a link that you will find on the website. And in case you have family or friends who want to follow the event via streaming, they can do so through the same link.

12. Can I decide where my companions will sit? And me?

No, guest seats will be assigned at the entrance. And that of the students will be assigned to you in alphabetical order on the same day of the event.

13. Is there access for people with reduced mobility and strollers for children?

Yes, when booking tickets, you must check the disabled access box.

14. Is there car and motorcycle parking?

Yes, there is parking at the Campus of La Salle-URL but we cannot guarantee availability for everyone that day. Access to the car park is on [Lluçanès street](#).

15. What is the dress code?

The dress code for all acts is formal.

16. Where can I see the photos of my graduation ceremony?

We will have an official photographer and we will upload the photos to the La Salle Campus Barcelona Flickr profile so that you can download them for free. There will also be a photocall at the end of the act outside the theatre.

17. What measures to prevent Covid-19 do I have to take on the day of the event?

There are currently no restrictions for any of the events.

18. Where do I go to get my diploma once the graduation ceremony has been held?

Once you have finished your bachelor's or master's degree, you must go to the Academic Secretary's Office to collect your diploma, which is located in the Sant Jaume building, on the ground floor.
